### REQUIREMENTS FOR OHIO STATE FAIR COMMITTEE YOUTH STAFF

Applicants must be registered with the Boy Scouts of America, be at least 14 years of age and hold the minimum rank of First Class or equivalent. **There will be no exceptions to these requirements.** Applicants must be outgoing, willing to talk to Fairgoers, and have a good knowledge of the Scout program.

Complete uniforms are desired, but not absolutely essential. Uniforms shall be worn correctly – shirts tucked in, buttons buttoned, etc. If Scout shorts are worn, official socks shall be worn.

Each Youth Staff member must work a minimum of four (4) hours per day of participation. Individuals will be evaluated daily for continued participation and may be asked to terminate such participation due to unsatisfactory performance, misbehavior, etc. Should an individual prove unsatisfactory for any reason during his/her hours of work, the parent or guardian will be notified by telephone that the Youth Staff member is being dismissed from the Scout display area.

Arrangements for transportation to and from the Fairgrounds are the Youth Staff member's responsibility.

The Ohio State Fair Committee shall assume no responsibility for individuals at times other than while they are actually working at either the inside or outside display areas at the Youth Discovery Center (Lausche Building). However, individuals shall conduct themselves in a Scout-like manner while on any part of the Fairgrounds. Failure to do so could result in termination of membership on the Committee. All of us are representatives of the Boy Scouts of America and are in the public eye. In many instances, the visitors to the Fair judge all members of the BSA by what they observe at the Scout booth. We, as Scouts and Scouters, are goodwill ambassadors for Scouting.

The Committee will consider each applicant individually. Submittal of the application is not a guarantee that the applicant will be accepted.

The parent/guardian of the Youth Staff member agrees to permit any member of the Ohio State Fair Committee to obtain medical attention for the Youth Staff member should it be necessary

By his/her signature on the application, the parent/guardian verifies that he/she has read and understands the requirements for participation as a Youth Staff member.
